	Multi-Year Grants	Up to three years of support for programs or projects previously supported by a Community Grant, or for administrative capacity building	2-Stage Application Stage 1 due Apr. 30 (decision in Sept.)
	Major Capital Grants	Requests of \$100,000 and greater for major capital programs	2-Stage Application Stage 1 due Mar. 30 (decision in Nov.)
Special Program Grants	Camp and Summer Program Grants	Up to \$10,000 for summer programming activities for disadvantaged children and youth	Feb. 15 (decision in Apr.)
	Growing Active Kids Grants	Grants for cultural, educational or recreational opportunities for children and youth living in and around social housing.	Apr. 15 (decision in May) Oct. 15 (decision in Nov.)
	Literacy for Life Grants	Up to \$4,000 for intergenerational literacy programs across Manitoba	Feb. 1 (for spring and summer programs) Jun. 1 (for fall programs) Oct. 1 (for winter programs)
	Professional Development Grants	Grants to help charitable organizations access professional development learning opportunities	Conferences and workshops Ongoing intake Advanced management, Training and Mentorships Ongoing intake
