Since 2005, The Winnipeg Foundation's Summer Internship Program has been matching Youth in Philanthropy participants with hands-on, full-time, paid summer jobs in the non-profit sector.





WHY APPLY?

- You'll gain unique work experience and a professional edge in the workplace once the program is finished.
- Intern positions pay \$13.25 an hour.
- You'll learn more about community and get satisfaction from helping others.
- You'll work one-on-one with a mentor to gain insight into the charitable sector.

ABOUT THE JOBS

- Job descriptions vary with the host organization.
- The Winnipeg Foundation staff will match qualifying applicants with organizations based on the student's interests and skills, and the needs of the particular organization.
- All jobs will provide students with a hands-on opportunity to gain skills and experience in the charitable sector.
- Host organizations are responsible for providing training, guidance, and mentorship to students.
- Successful student applicants will be notified of their position in mid-June.
- The jobs begin in early July and end in late August. A typical work week is 35 hours, Monday to Friday.

ELIGIBILITY

(to apply for an internship, you must):

- Have attended high school for the school year, and have participated in The Winnipeg Foundation's YiP program for at least one year.
- Be at least 16 years old as of July 1st the year you apply.
- Be a Canadian citizen or a landed immigrant.
- Demonstrate an interest in a career in the voluntary sector.
- Be available to work full-time from the beginning of July until the end of August.

**Please note: If you have already been an intern in SIP, you are not eligible to apply again.

Applications for interns will open on March 7, 2022 and are due by April 15, 2022 at 4:30 p.m.
