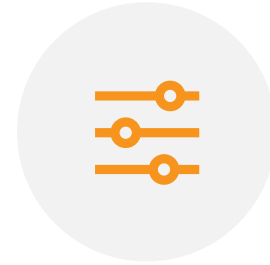

Children and Youth Program Grants - We've Amalgamated:

- Nourishing Potential
 - Supported requests from children and youth programs for nutritious food, kitchen equipment, nutrition education, and food handler training.
- Camp and Summer Program Grants
 - Supported requests for fun summer programming for children and youth facing physical, health, or socio-economic barriers.
- Growing Active Kids
 - Supported requests from youth-serving organizations to partner with other community agencies and deliver services in and around Edgeland, Gilbert Park, Plessis/Mission Gardens and Valley Gardens Manitoba Housing communities.

What this Means

- Same amount of overall funding available
- Access three funds with one application
 - Nourishing Potential, Camp and Summer Program Grants, and Growing Active Kids are no longer accepting applications
 - Summer Internship Program is still active
- New policies and criteria
 - Enabling organizations to ask for what they need in one application while still meeting the trust conditions of the old funds

Children and Youth Program Grants

- Awards grants of up to \$25,000 to youth-serving organizations or established youth programs that serve children and youth facing systemic barriers to participation, including BIPOC and 2SLGBTQ+ youth, youth from economically disadvantaged communities, and youth with disabilities or chronic illnesses.

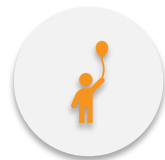

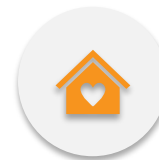

Eligibility

- Registered charity or other qualified donee
- Project must primarily benefit the people of Winnipeg
- One Children and Youth Program Grant per calendar year
 - Can still apply for a Community Grant or other special program grant in the same calendar year, but it must be for a different project (i.e. we can't pay for the same thing twice)
 - Grant history is always a factor in review
- Final report will be required before organizations are eligible to apply again
- Projects must serve children and youth facing systemic barriers to participation

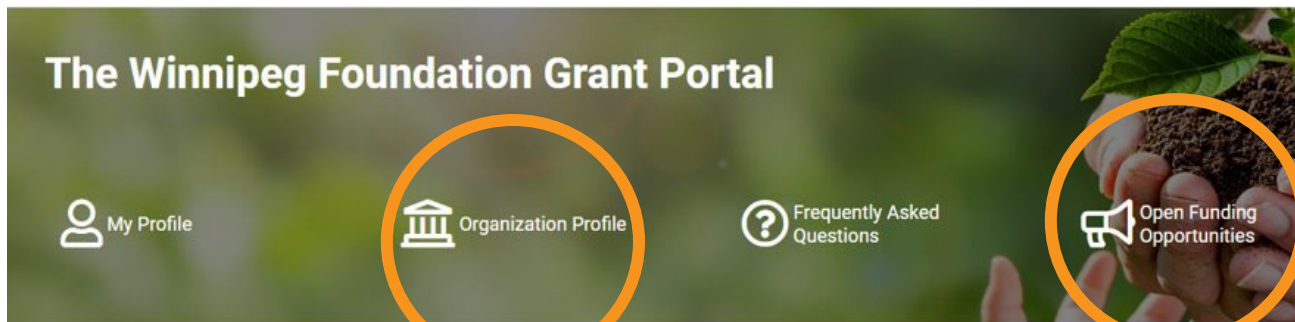


