Multi-Year Grants Policies

The Winnipeg Foundation makes granting decisions based on an application's merit and does not discriminate on the basis of actual or perceived group characteristics as identified in the Manitoba Human Rights Code. Organizations applying for a grant from The Winnipeg Foundation must also adhere to the Manitoba Human Rights Code.

Program Description: Multi-Year Grants awards flexible funding to enhance the capacity of an organization. 50% of the successful recipients of this grant are from equity-led community organizations.

Maximum request amount: up to \$150,000 per year for four years

Eligibility:

- Only registered charities or other qualified donees are eligible to apply for grants from The Winnipeg Foundation.
- Organizations must be based in Winnipeg and their programs must primarily benefit the people of Winnipeg.
- Organizations must have a grant history with The Winnipeg Foundation and, within the last three years, have received and reported on one Community Grant or Adapt Grant.
- Organizations must have an annual operating budget (revenues) of \$10 million or less.
- National organizations may apply but must demonstrate that they have been operating in Winnipeg for at least three years with permanent, full-time staff; a fully operational location; and local representation on the Board of Directors.

Grants are not made to, or for:

- Exclusively religious activities (defined as religious worship or instruction), or organizations that engage in proselytizing (defined as converting or recruiting people to a specific set of religious or other beliefs), particularly in the case of youth or other impressionable audiences;
- Organizations whose primary purpose is grantmaking or scholarship/award programs.

Successful Multi-Year Grant Applicants:

Multi-Year recipients will not be eligible to apply for a Community Grant or Children and Youth Program Grant during the term of their Multi-Year funding agreement.
